## Generation 1

1. **Grace Elizabeth Atkinson**, daughter of Edward Elbert Atkinson and Esther Jane Burns, was born on Dec 11, 1916 in Waskada, Manitoba. She died on Jun 04, 2008 in Truro, Colchester County, NS, Canada. She married **George Clifford Retson** on Jul 26, 1941 in Ottawa, Ontario. He was born on Dec 19, 1912 in Truro, Colchester County, NS, Canada. He died on Feb 17, 1997 in Truro, Colchester County, NS, Canada.

Notes for Grace Elizabeth Atkinson:

Grace Elizabeth Retson (nee Atkinson) born 11 December 1916, "10 to 6 P.M. - she had supper and never stopped eating (according to her mother) third child of Ed and Jean Atkinson. She moved from Wascada to Kerrobert when she 6 weeks old. She attended schools in Kerrobert. She was almost always first in her class. She sang in the Junior choir where she sang solos in the Junior choir and quartets with Alexa Baxter, Gladis Hanbidge and a fourth. She started to play the violin in Grade 10. and played in an orchestra for all the church suppers within 20 miles. The Minister, Benson Summers would go to sing solos and Grace would accompany him on the Piano. She sang in the Senior choir her last year or two at home. She graduated from grade 12 in 1934 and then attended business college in Saskatoon. She went to Success Business college (Typing and Shorthand) from July 15 until she got a job at Ashdown's Hardware in January and subsequently for W. H. Hellofs in Kerrobert. She worked for 6 weeks before being laid off. She went back to Success Business college to pick up some courses and then in June commenced work for MacDonald's Consolidated, a wholesale for Safeway for the summer.

She passed Civil Service Exams (stenographic) in 1935 and got a job in the Federal seed branch for six months. She next had a job as head stenographer of a group of 12 with Massey Harris at Regina for \$60. She had written the Civil Service Clerical exams in Saskatoon before leaving for the Regina job and came fourth in Canada. She was offered a job with the 1936 census at \$75.00 a month where she worked for 13 months with the Bureau of Statistics. September 1 1937 she transferred to the Department of Agriculture, Economics division on the promise of her getting a Grade two at \$90. month after 6 months or so. After two years at \$60 a month she accepted a position with the Ottawa Journal for \$80 where she worked 6 months or so. She then became secretary to the chief of the legal division of the Department of Munitions and Supply for \$90. In 1940 she joined the Senate staff. She met Cliff Retson in January 1938 and in June 1938 they started going out nightly until he left for a road trip on his job. She would date Cliff when he was in Ottawa 6 months each year. They were married on 26 July 1941. She followed her husband who served as a 1st Lieut in the Canadian Artillery across Canada. On November 11, 1949 they moved to 2020 Prince St. Colchester county which was latter renumbered 2031 Prince. She was employed as a Court Stenographer in Truro and has the distinction of being appointed the first female Justice of the Peace in Nova Scotia

Grace took an active interest in music, home and school. She was an avid bridge player. She took university courses over the years and graduated with her B.A. from St. Mary University at age 64. (Diploma dated May 11 1981) Grace also took an avid interest in multiculturalism. She joined the Multicultural Association of Colchester at its inception in 1975, served as a Board member for many years. She served as secretary and then vice-president of the Multicultural Association of Nova Scotia. On November 4th 2000 at their 25th Anniversary she received an award presented by the Lieutenant Governor of Nova Scotia Myra A Freeman, where she received a standing ovation. In 2001 she was nominated for an Order of Nova Scotia. Later in life she became an avid traveler. When Cliff and Grace retired in 1977 they traveled to visit son Donald to London, England for a week and then took a 2 week European trip taking in Paris, Munich, Heidelberg, Lucerne, Switzerland, Venice, Florence, and Rome and then returned to France by Hydroplane from Calais to Dover. After another week in London they took a train to Annan to visit Scottish relatives. On another trip in 1991-2 they flew to San Francisco, then Hong Kong for 4 days, then a 3 week cruise on the Queen Elizabeth II taking in Xiamem, Tangin and the Great Wall of China, Osaka, Yokohama and Tokyo, Japan. When she was 84 she traveled to Portugal for two weeks, California for a week, Moosonee, Ontario for eleven days and just after her 85th birthday traveled to Kenora, Ontario for Christmas and then on to Edmonton to visit her children outside Nova Scotia.

Stories told by Grace When she was young she and her brother Donald played house where she would be the mother and nurse and he the father and doctor. On one occasion he was the postman and on a shoe box he wrote poste bocks. She was so mad at him that she wouldn't play with him for the rest of the day. The next day he had an operation, got an infection and died.

RETSON, Grace Elizabeth - 91, Truro, passed away peacefully, Wednesday, June 4, 2008, in the Mira Long Term Care Facility, Truro. Grace was born in Waskada, Man., a daughter of the late Edward and Jean (Burns) Atkinson, and grew up in Kerrobert, Sask. She attended secretarial school in Saskatoon and after retiring, received her Bachelor of Arts (cum laude, 1981) from St. Mary's University. She met Cliff Retson, her husband of 56 years, while working at the Senate in Ottawa. They wed on July 26, 1941 and moved to Truro in 1947 where Grace worked as a provincial court reporter. She was appointed Nova Scotia's first female justice of the peace in 1969. Grace was a member of First Baptist Church and Truro Duplicate Bridge Club. She was a founding member of the Colchester County Multicultural Association and served on the executive of the provincial association, which honoured her with a special award for her outstanding contributions. She is survived by her children, Ted (Beverly), Jane (Gordon) Earle, Jim (Roberta), Mavis (Marc) Yorke, Donald (Joscelyn), Bob (Carol); "foster" sons, Charles Agobia and Manassah M'khabela; grandchildren, Donna Lee, Kathy, Lynda, James, Jillie, Julia, Nicholas, Katherine, Andrew, Etienne, Serena, Colin, Craig and Christina, and nine great-grandchildren. Husband, Cliff; sister, Jean MacRae; brothers, Donald and William Atkinson, and grandson, Daniel Retson, predeceased her. Visitation will be held at the Mattatall ~ Varner Funeral Home, 55 Young St., Truro, Saturday 7-9 p.m. The funeral will be in First Baptist Church on Sunday at 2 p.m. with Rev. Andy Crowell officiating. A reception will follow in the church hall. Interment will then be held in Crossroads Cemetery, Valley. Notes for George Clifford Retson:

Cliff Retson was born on the campus of the Nova Scotia Agriculture College, Bible Hill, Colchester County, Nova Scotia and lived in a small house on the campus until 1928 when the family moved to 101 Ryland Ave. He attended school at College Road School until Grade 9 and Colchester County Academy. He graduated from the Academy in 1929 and entered Acadia University where he studied in economics. He was a skilled athlete excelling in Basket Ball and Track and field. He graduated with a B.A. in 1933 (diploma dated May 24 1933) He attended NSAC 1933 - 1934.

He commenced work with the Department of Agriculture in 1934. He worked with the department in Newfoundland 1934 and 1935. He went to Ottawa in August 1936 and worked with the Department of Agriculture Canada until the advent of the war, 1939.

He served in the army stationed first at Pettawawa, Officer training program in Brockville, Ontario, Shilo, Manitoba and Esquimalt B.C.

Cliff married Grace Atkinson on 26 July 1941 in Ottawa. Cliff was called up from the reserve to the active army in September 1942 and was transferred to Nova Scotia. Grace followed on October 10. Grace stayed at 101 Ryland Ave. that winter. In spring of 1943 Cliff left for a 6 week stay in Trois Riviere and then on to Brockville for four months. Grace went to Peg Embree on Collin Ave

off Eglinton. She worked for Underwood who provided office help. On her last job she worked at Plaxton law firm.

Cliff was transferred to Shilo October 1943 and Grace moved to Ottawa. They visit each other at Portage La Prairie for Christmas with sister Jean. After Grace moved to Brandon for the winter at a family called McGills. Cliff would come in from Shilo on week ends. Cliff took off for Prince Rupert (Japanese threat) in spring of 1944 and was then sent on a 6 week course in Esquimalt. Grace went to Victoria to stay with friend from Kerrobert, Muriel Gardener who had rented a bungalow house in Victoria. Ted was born a day latter at the Royal Jubilee Hospital in Victoria. In fall of 1944 Cliff was then transferred to Prince George until the end of January 1945 and then to Pettawawa, Ontario. Grace moved to Pembroke. Following the war, he entered the Department of Labour in Ottawa until he transferred back to the Department of Agriculture. He moved back to Bible Hill in 1947 (July 1) to take charge of the federal agriculture economic branch , first located on the NSAC campus. July and August 1947 was spent at 101 Ryland. In September 1947 they rented an apartment from Arleigh Burgess on 112 Main St. Bible Hill. On November 11 1948 they moved to Queen St. Truro. They moved to 2020 Prince St. Salmon River on November 11 1949. The municipal address latter changed to 2031.

He attended Cornell University in 1949 spring term. Cliff went back to Cornell at the end of January 1950 and came home for July and August. He went back for the fall term and came home for Christmas. He received his M.Sc. during Spring convocation 1951. Diploma dated January 31 1951

2. **Edward Elbert Atkinson**, son of Edward Atkinson and Abigail Almeda Spicer, was born on Feb 26, 1887 in Merrickville, Ontario. He died on Jan 14, 1957 in Vancouver, British Columbia (Age at Death 69). He married **Esther Jane Burns** on Jan 25, 1912 in Wascada, Langford, Manitoba.
3. **Esther Jane Burns**, daughter of Robert Burns and Jane McNab, was born on Jul 26, 1886 in Neepawa, Manitoba. She died on Feb 11, 1961 in Vancouver, British Columbia (Age at Death 74).

Notes for Edward Elbert Atkinson:

Edward Elbert Atkinson the second child of Edward Atkinson was born 26 February 1887 at Merrickville, Ontario.

He lived in a farm at Merrickville before moving with his family to Smith Falls. His father was a butcher in Smith Falls. He went to school until he was 14 years. He played the Trombone in the Town band.

He worked for Frost and Woods a Manufacturing plant. He went out on a harvest excursion to Manitoba. He went to Wascada. He met and married Jean Burns.

When ever a hobo would come into town and ask for a meal. Ed would send them to the Chinese restaurant for a meal and he would pay the owner. In 1924 when Ed was laid up for three months in bed with what was thought to be lead poisoning there was a message from the owner that his

wife and children were to come for dinner each day at no charge. Jean never went once. He would install furnaces in the summer time for up to 50 miles of Kerrobert. When the farmer would get paid for their crops they would pay him. In the thirties the farmers couldn't pay and Ed cashed in his entire life insurance to pay Ashdown's Wholesaler where he had purchased the furnaces. Both he and his wife thought that debts should be paid. Money was lent to you on good faith and you should honour that faith. He was one of the few allowed to charge credit on Ashdown's

From "Wilkie, Saskatchewan, 1908-1988. Volume 1", Wilkie History Society:

Ed. Atkinson, Tinsmith, Plumber

Ed Atkinson came to Wilkie from Kerrobert with his wife Esther. They have two daughters, Mrs. A.E. McRae and Mrs. Cliff Retson. He conducted a plumbing and tinsmith in business at Wilkie for some years during the 1940s. In 1944 Ed Atkinson advertised that he did complete installations in town and country. His motto was Service He kept a listing in the Wilkie Directory.

Mr. and Mrs. Atkinson left Wilkie in 1948 and moved to Vancouver. The R.M. of Buffalo purchased Ed Atkinson's tin shop on Second Avenue. Mr. Atkinson passed away at Vancouver in January of 1957. He was 70 years old

Notes for Esther Jane Burns:

Esther Jean Atkinson (nee Burns) provided a fair description of many relatives in a written page in April 1952. This page was typed up by her daughter Mrs G.C. Retson.

Esther Jean Atkinson (nee Burns and called Jean) was born 26 July 1886. She graduated from grade 11 in Neepawa and then attended Normal College in Winnipeg for three months where she got a second class certificate. She taught school for 8 years.

She was terrific in English especially Bobby Burns poetry.

She married Ed Atkinson 25 January 1912. They lived in Waskada from 1912 to 1917. Three children Ethel Jean born 30 October 1913, William Burns, 24 July 1915 and Grace Elizabeth, 11 December 1916. Billie died of an obstructed bowel at three months and was buried in the Burns plot in Neepawa Cemetery.

Robert Donald born in 1 November 1920 had an appendectomy operation and died thirty days latter at age 8. He was buried at Kerrobert.

In the depression she entered several essay contest to win several prizes including a contest, " Why every woman needed an electric Iron." and first prize in a contest with Saskatchewan Pheonix.

In 1937-38 her husband worked in Timmins taking a course in air conditioning. In the winter of 1942-43 he worked his trade at an internment camp in Medicine Hat. In the fall of 1943 they moved to Meyerthorpe, North of Edmonton. In the summer 1944 he set up a gunsmithing and plumbing business in Wilkie, Saskatchewan. In 1948 they moved to Vancouver. Ed died in 1957 and Jean in 1962.

Jean had a rough life with several operations. She belonged to a women's missionary society.

Esther Jane Burns and Edward Elbert Atkinson had the following children:

- i. Ethel Jean Atkinson was born on Oct 30, 1913 in Waskada, Manitoba. She died on Feb 14, 1994 in Ottawa, Ontario. She married Edmund Alexander McRae on Dec 19, 1941 in Kerrobert, Saskatchewan. He was born on Nov 15, 1914 in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. He died on May 27, 1998 in Ottawa, Ontario.

Notes for Ethel Jean Atkinson:

Ethel Jean McRae (nee Atkinson) completed her school in Kerrobert and graduated from the University of Saskatchewan at age 22. She worked as a secretary to the Manager of Safeway and then accepted an appointment by the Civil Service of Canada, as agriculture Assistant, Dominion Economics Division, Dept. of Agriculture with headquarters at the University of Saskatchewan. She married her university friend, Edmund Alexander McRae in 1941. He attended the University of Saskatchewan, later enlisting as a navigator with the R.C.A.F.

Notes for Edmund Alexander McRae:

He attended University of Saskatchewan. he enlisted as a navigator in the R.C.A.F.

- ii. William Burns Atkinson was born on Jul 24, 1915 in Waskada, Manitoba. He died on Nov 08, 1915 in Waskada, Manitoba.

Notes for William Burns Atkinson:

Died at three months of an obstructed bowel. Buried in Burns Plot at Neepawa.

Notes for Robert Donald Atkinson:

Grace Retson:

The Sunday before Donald died he was to go into the Hospital for an operation for chronic appendix. Donald and Grace were playing in the 2nd unfinished floor. Mum had her dolls and doll dressing. Donald had his tricycle. He would play mailman and buy the groceries.

Mum had postbox (a white shoe box which she was so proud of) which Donald had written "poste bocks". Grace was so mad she refused to play with him. Donald was sad and went downstairs and told his mother Grace wouldn't play with him. Mrs Atkinson said that they were having so much fun why wouldn't she play with Donald. But (according to Mum: I had spoken, I was too pig headed. So Mrs Atkinson spent the rest of the day reading to him and occupying his day.

He went in 3rd and died on 30th. Grace saw him a week before he died. She went in and visited him, she was not supposed to ask questions or have him take. She started to read some stories when the Doctor came in. The Doctor ask her who told her she could come in. Grace replied that her mother had and did she want her to wait outside. The Doctor told her she should go home.

The Monday after his death, Grace was talking to a neighbour, Mrs Pedersen. She came up to visit Mr and Mrs Atkinson and Grace was upstairs in the her bedroom crying. Grace told her story about the box. Mrs Pedtersen told her not to worry about the box.

The night before her brother Donald died Grace prayed that her brother would live. She says she knows that she spoke to God and that she said he told her Donald would live. She woke up in the night and ask who the people in the living room Her father told her the Minister had walked them home from the Hospital. He didn't tell her Donald had just died.

Mum left home when September 1934 at the age of 17 with \$50 bucks in her pocket. Her parents drove her to Saskatoon to Business College.

### Generation 3

4. **Edward Atkinson**, son of Thomas Atkinson and Margaret Holiston, was born on Feb 16, 1858 in Near Merrickville. He died on Jan 09, 1944. He married **Abigail Almeda Spicer** on Dec 03, 1879 in Merrickville, Grenville, Ontario (Names are misspelled as Atkenson and Abigail's middle name as Alexander).
5. **Abigail Almeda Spicer**, daughter of Robert Nicholson Spicer and Elizabeth Jane Perrin, was born on Sep 13, 1860 in Prescott, Ontario, Canada. She died on Jul 10, 1940 in Merrickville, Ontario, Canada.

Notes for Edward Atkinson:

First of 8 children - four boys and 4 girls. Grace Retson indicates this family farmed in Ferland Saskatchewan before returning to Merrickville.

Later memorandum: Thomas Atkinson who emigrated from Armagh , Northern Ireland settled on a quarter section with his parents William Atkinson and Jane (Coulter) Atkinson. Later he married Margaret Holliston. When son Edward married Abbie Spicer Thomas gave his son a quarter section across and opposite his farm , along with a team of horses a cow some machinery and equipment. He did this for each one of his sons until the last son Tommy who got the homestead.

Ed and his family stayed on this farm until about 1897. Ed and a man name of Burchall entered into a butcher business in Perth. They subsequent moved to Smith Falls

Notes for Abigail Almeda Spicer:

Abigail Almeda Spicer, daughter of Robert Nicholson and Elizabeth Jane (Perrin) Spicer, was born 13 September 1860, in Prescott, Ontario, Canada. She married Edward Atkinson on 3 December 1879 in Maynard, Ontario. She died 10 Jul 1940 in Merrickville, Ontario, Canada. Her grand daughter Grace Retson recalls staying with her Grandmother in Ferland Saskatchewan when she was very young and sharing a bed. Unlike her Grandmother Burns who was quite stylish, Grace recalls she wore long skirts to the floor and 4 slips on at least one occasion.

Abigail Almeda Spicer and Edward Atkinson had the following children:

- i. Ethel May Atkinson was born on Jan 27, 1881 in Merrickville, Ontario. She died on Apr 22, 1884 in Merrickville (Village), Leeds & Grenville (North/Nord), Ontario, Canada.

Notes for Ethel May Atkinson:

This Ethel is where Jean McRae got her name Abigail wanted The girl to be renamed Ethel May but Jean Atkinson thought Ethel was sufficient and choose Jean as the other name.

- ii. William Thomas Atkinson was born on May 15, 1882 in Wolford Township, Ontario. He died on Apr 26, 1978 in Ottawa, Ontario. He married Jane Elizabeth Otto on Aug 02, 1909 in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. She was born on Dec 29, 1880 in Osgoode, Russell, Ontario, Canada. She died on May 14, 1947 in Ottawa, Ontario (Age: 65).

Notes for William Thomas Atkinson:  
Known to Retson family as Uncle Will

- iii. Etta Atkinson was born on Aug 29, 1884 in Merrickville, Ontario. She died on Jun 07, 1975 in Vancouver, BC. She married Howard Phillips on Dec 07, 1912. He died on Jul 11, 1954.

She was a tailor in Smith Falls

He married Esther Jane Burns on Jan 25, 1912 in Waskada, Langford, Manitoba. She was born on Jul 26, 1886 in Neepawa, Manitoba. She died on Feb 11, 1961 in Vancouver, British Columbia (Age at Death 74).
- 6. **Robert Burns**, son of Robert Burns and Elizabeth Richardson, was born on May 14, 1853 in Brussels, Huron County, Ontario. He died in Dec 1929 in Regina, Saskatchewan. He married **Jane McNab** on Dec 04, 1878 in Morris Township, Huron County, Ontario, Canada (Wife's name in Registry in McNabb).
- 7. **Jane McNab**, daughter of Daniel McNab and Grace Campbell, was born on Nov 06, 1858 in Walton, Ontario. She died in 1941 in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada.

Notes for Robert Burns:

Robert Burns (2nd) known as Bob, married Jane McNab on 4 December 1878 and in 1881 along with infant daughter Grace moved to homestead in Elkhorn Manitoba. In 1884 or 1885 he traded his land at Elkhorn, Manitoba for a quarter section at Neepawa. Later he bought an adjoining quarter and lived there to 1897.

He retired from farming in 1917 and moved to Regina. Renting the farm to son Bob who had been given the first quarter. Robert died in 1929 and his wife in 1941

Notes for Jane McNab:

Jane McNab daughter of Daniel was born on 6 November 1858 or 59.

Jane McNab and Robert Burns had the following children:

- i. Grace Burns was born in Mar 1880 in Brussels, Huron County, Ontario. She died in Jun 1889 in Neepawa, Manitoba.

Notes for Grace Burns:  
She died in a diphtheria epidemic in 1889 at the age of nine.

- ii. Elizabeth Richardson Burns was born on Apr 20, 1882 in Elkhorn, Manitoba. She died in Mar 1958 in Regina, Saskatchewan.

Notes for Elizabeth Richardson Burns:

Elizabeth Richardson Burns born in April 1882 taught school for several years. She moved to Edmonton where she took a business course. She returned to Regina where her parents had moved in 1917. She served as secretary to the chief of police for 26 years.

- iii. Margaret Emma Burns was born on Sep 04, 1883 in Elkhorn, Manitoba. She died on Oct 17, 1957 in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. She married John (Jack) Alexander Stevenson on Jul 15, 1913 in Neepawa, Manitoba. He was born on Oct 24, 1877 in Listowel, Ontario. He died on Oct 11, 1953 in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

Notes for Margaret Emma Burns:

Margaret Emma Stevenson (nee Burns) born 4 September 1883 married John (Jack) Stevenson in 1913. They moved to Saskatchewan and after living in a couple of villages moved to Saskatoon.

- iv. Robert Burns was born on May 02, 1885 in Neepawa, Manitoba. He died on Nov 30, 1950 in Neepawa, Manitoba. He married Florence Helen Cruickshank on Jun

15, 1917 in Neepawa, Manitoba. She was born on Apr 06, 1891 in Of Oakdale District. She died on Aug 27, 1982 in Neepawa, Manitoba.

Notes for Robert Burns:

This was the sibling that sister Jean was closest to. Grace Retson met him only once during the war years when they were stationed at Shilo. Robert Burns(3rd) remained with his parents on the farm bought in 1897 from his father-in-law after they retired to Regina.

3. v. Esther Jane Burns was born on Jul 26, 1886 in Neepawa, Manitoba. She died on Feb 11, 1961 in Vancouver, British Columbia (Age at Death 74). 14 May 1634: "By consent of William Gallerd, administrator to John Russell[,] & Roberte Fibbin, it is ordered, that in consideration of some service performed at sea by the said Roberte Fibbin, & 3 months service in New England, that the said Roberte Fibbin shall be set free, & have £1 13s 5d forgiven him, which he ought to his master, John Russell" [ [MBCR 1:121](#)].

COMMENT: The appointment of WILLIAM GAYLORD as administrator suggests that both ROBERT FIBBIN , of whom there is no further record, and JOHN RUSSELL , his master, were living in Dorchester, and were from the West Country. Both probably sailed on the unnamed ship from Weymouth which arrived in New England in July 1633.

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP: The claim has been made that William Gaylord was made deacon of the Dorchester church before the Mary & John sailed, and it seems to be certain that he was deacon as soon as that ship arrived in New England. In the earliest town records all the acts of the town were signed by four men: John Warham, John Maverick, William Rockwell and William Gaylord [ [DTR 1-7](#)]. Warham and Maverick were the ministers of the church, and Rockwell and Gaylord would seem to be the deacons. Also on 26 August 1633 William Gaylord and William Rockwell were appointed administrators to the estate of John Russell who had died in Dorchester, and this is a diaconal function. Neither William Gaylord nor his wife was admitted to the second church at Dorchester, organized late in 1636, clearly indicating that he retained his membership in the Warham church, where he continued as deacon after he moved to Connecticut.

In his will, dated 31 January 1671[2] (with codicils dated 14 November 1672 and 18 December 1672) and proved in September 1673, "William Gaylord of Windsor, seriously considering my age," bequeathed to "my son John Gaylord, his heirs & assignes" all my housing and home lot and orchard bounded by "my daughter Hoskins" provided my son John freely resigns up his propriety in his own dwelling house & barn & orchard & land to "my grandson John Birge ... his heirs and assignes"; if "my son John" refuse to make the exchange, then "my grandson John Birge" to enjoy my house and homelot as it is bounded; to "my beloved son John Gaylord & my beloved grandson John Birge" sixteen acres of meadow in the Great Meadow divided between them; to "my grandson John Birge" ten rods breadth in the parcel of land I bought of Mr. Hanaford on the east side of the great river; to "Hezikiah Gaylord my grandson (who now lives with my son John)" four rods breadth in the land over the great river "that lieth next to the land I gave his father"; to "my son Walter Gaylord" ten rods breadth in the land over the great river; to "my son Samuel Gaylord" ten rods breadth in the land over the great river; to "my son John" the remaining part of my whole lot on the east side of the great river with the barn standing thereon; to "my daughter Elizabeth Hoskins, of whose dutiful & tender respect to me I have had good experience & great comfort in having by this my will disposed of part of my estate to her son John (who hath and is a great help in supporting of me in my old age), I am not able to do for her as otherwise I would, but as a token of my love to her I give her one of my great kettles, the brass or copper one, which she pleaseth"; son John Gaylord sole executor; Capt. Benjamin Newberry and John Allyn of Hartford, overseers. In a codicil dated 14 November 1672 "the Lord having lengthened out my life longer than I expected" he bequeathed "as a testimony of my fatherly affection to my daughter Elizabeth Hoskins one of my cows and household goods"; to my grandchild John Birge my bay mare and the great table and form in the fire room below. In a codicil dated 18 December 1672 he bequeathed to "his grandson John Birg" tools; to "my daughter Birge" a white and black hog [ [Hartford PD Case #2140](#)].

The inventory of "the estate of Deacon Willaim Gaylor who deceased July 20, 1673," was taken 2 August 1673 and totalled £296 17s. 6d., of which £230 was real estate: "his housing, homelot & pasture adjoining," £59; "16 acres of land in the Great Meadow," £80; "land on the east side of the Great River being 34 poles in breadth by the river," £68; "18 acres of land by Rocky Hill," £3; and "39 acres of land near Pine Meadow," £20 [ [Hartford PD Case #2140](#)].

ASSOCIATIONS: In 1910 J. Henry Lea and J.R. Hutchinson published the 19 April 1634 will of Joan Patten of Crewkerne, in which she makes a bequest of £5 to "William Gaylard in New England"; based on this will they abstracted several Gaylord wills, mostly from the Taunton registry [ NYGBR 41:183-90]. These abstracts are especially valuable as the originals of these wills were destroyed in the bombing of Exeter in 1942.

Lea and Hutchinson argue that Joan Patten and William Gaylord could not have been siblings, and suggest that she was his aunt, and that William Gaylord was somehow connected to the Gaylords of Pitminster, Somersetshire. Thirty years later John Insley Coddington noted that the will of Joan Patten pointed directly at Crewkerne, and there he found the baptism of three of the sons of the immigrant 17:71-74]. (Coddington missed the baptism of one son, which was found many years later 61:96.) Coddington further notes that the surname Gaylord was common in the West Country and brands as "sheer nonsense" the ascription to the immigrant of noble French ancestry.

Benjamin H. Gaylord commissioned further research in England, the results of which he published in 1982 58:218-23]. While he did not solve the problem, Gaylord did dispel a number of myths, eliminate a few possibilities, and provide a solid foundation for future research. Like Coddington he warns against focussing only on the Pitminster Gaylords.

Richard Treat of Wethersfield had married in England in 1615 Alice Gaylord, daughter of Hugh Gaylord of Pitminster; any connection between her and William Gaylord would seem to be remote

Col. Charles Edward Banks suggested that William Gaylord was of the family of Chilthorne Domer, Somersetshire, but without citing his evidence Pop(p13852,160,192); 140]. In 1628 Ann the wife of William "Gaylerd" of Whitchurch, Dorsetshire, was taxed as a "recusant convict" Pop(p13831,90,108);> 26:7; nothing connects this William Gaylord with the New England man.

COMMENTS: On 1 May 1639 "William Gaylard of Windsore upon the river of Kennecticot in America, planter," acted as agent for JOHN WARHAM and his wife in arranging the lease of lands in Dorchester [ Lechford 124-25]. On 29 July 1639 "Will[i]am Gaylard" of Windsor, planter, was surety for Thomas Marshfield of Windsor [ Lechford 136-37].

Several sources speak of a John Gaylord in Dorchester early, and make him brother of William. The only evidence for this is a colony record of 9 May 1632 in which "Will[i]am Felpes & John Gallard" are the Dorchester delegates to a meeting which would form the beginning of the House of Deputies [ MBCR 1:95]. Since William Gaylord was after this date regularly deputy from both

Dorchester and Windsor, the more likely explication is that this is a scribal error for William Gaylord, and that a John Gaylord did not exist in Dorchester or in Massachusetts Bay at this time

EDUCATION: His inventory included "3 books" valued at 8s. His widow, Margaret, signed her will.

ESTATE: In the 1623 Plymouth division of land, "Robart Hicces" was granted one acre as a passenger on the Fortune, and his wife and children were granted four acres as passengers on the Anne [ PCR 12:5, 6]. In the 1627 Plymouth division of cattle Robert Hicks, Margaret Hicks, Samuel Hicks, Ephraim Hicks, Lydia Hicks and Phebe Hicks were the sixth through eleventh persons in the twelfth company [ PCR 12:13].

Assessed 18s. in the Plymouth tax list of 25 March 1633 and 12s. in the list of 27 March 1634 [ PCR 1:9, 27]. "Robert Hicces" was thirty-seventh on the list of Purchasers [ PCR 2:177].

On 10 February 1629 Robert Hicks purchased two acres on the north side of town from Steven Dean [ PCR 12:7]. On 29 August 1638 Clement Briggs acknowledged his sale of "one acre of land in the upper fall near the second brook" to "Mr. Rob[er]te Heeks" [ PCR 12:34]. On 9 December 1639 "Mr. Rob[er]te Hicks" rented five acres at Reed Pond to John Smyth for three years, Smyth to fence the east side of the land [ PCR 12:51]. On 13 July 1639 George Sowle acknowledged his sale of two acres of land to Robert Hicks of Plymouth [ PCR 12:45]. On 20 July 1639 John Barnes of Plymouth, yeoman, acknowledged his sale of four acres of meadow at High Pynes to Mr. Robert Hicks [ PCR 12:45]. On 11 February 1639[40] Mr. Robert Hicks of Plymouth, planter, sold to Samuell Hicks his eldest son all his house, outhouses and garden in Plymouth, together with four acres of land and eight acres of land and all the meadow at the Heigh Pynes and Iland Creek, and all his right title and interest in the land, and three cows [ PCR 12:54]. On 7 April 1642 Mr. Robert Hicks sold two acres of marsh at Heigh Pines to Mr. William Bradford [ PCR 12:79]. On 7 May 1642 Mr. Robert Hicks sold seven acres of upland at Iland Creek to William Brett of Duxbury [ PCR 12:80]. On the same day he acknowledged his deed to John Reynor of three acres of marsh meadow at Heigh Pynes [ PCR 12:80]. On 9 October 1645 Mr. Robert Hicks sold to Georg Partrich a parcel of marsh meadow consisting of two acres [ PCR 12:115].

In his will, dated 28 May 1645 and proved 15 May 1648, "Robert Hicks of Plymouth ... being full of infirmities of body" bequeathed to "my son Ephraim all that my dwelling house barn and buildings with the gardens ... in Plymouth," also "all those three fields one lying on the north side of the said town of Plymouth ..., the second which I lately purchased of Mr. John Aldin and the third called the south field"; "but my mind and will is that my executrix hereafter named shall have and enjoy three rooms in the said house during her life she keeping herself unmarried, viz. the hall and chamber over and cellar underneath, and also that my said son Ephraim shall pay her the thirds of the said lands during her life and widowhood"; to "my said son Ephraim all my lands lying at Iland Creek on Duxbery side except two lots of upland of twenty acres apiece lying next unto Mr. Kemp's lands, which I hereby give and bequeath unto John Banges my grandchild"; to "my executrix ... the rents of the said land not set and let forth for six years yet to come if she shall so long live, but all the rest of my lands ... I give unto my said son Ephraim"; "I give unto John Reyner the son of Mr. John Reyner our teacher fifty acres of the purchased lands accruing ... to me as a purchaser of my share of lands lying at Seawams or Secunck if the said Mr. John Reyner his father do remain at Plymouth"; to "Samuell my eldest son" fifty acres; to "my said son Ephraim" fifty acres; to "John Watson" fifty acres; to "John Bangs" fifty acres; to "the younger of Mr. Charls Chancy's sons which his wife had at one birth when he dwelt at Plymouth" fifty acres; to "my said son Ephraim"

household goods; to the Town of Plymouth one cow calf; to "William Pontus" 20s.; to "John Faunce" 20s.; to "Nathaneell Morton" 20s.; to "Thomas Cushman" 20s.; "Margaret my loving wife" sole executrix and residue; Mr. John Howland, Mannasses Kempton and Thomas Cushman overseers; to John Howland and Mannasses Kemton 10s. each for a remembrance; to Joshua Prat "a suit of my wearing clothes with a pair of shoes and stockings"; to Samuell Eddy a pair of wearing stockings; to "my said son Ephraim ... my four oxen, paying my loving wife ... the thirds of the profits of the lands as is before mentioned ... and to draw her twenty loads of wood yearly to her house in Plymouth during her life" [ MD 8:144-46, citing PCPR 1:1:703].

The inventory of the estate of "Mr. Robert Hicks deceased the 24th of May 1647 taken the fifth of July in the year aforesaid also exhibited upon oath the 4th of May 1648" totalled £39 13s., with no real estate included [ MD 8:143-44, citing PCPR 1:1:69].

On 23 January 1648 John Rogers of Duxbury bought the rent of lands improved by Mr. Robert Hicks now deceased from Ephraim Hicks of Plymouth [ PCR 12:155-56].

On 1 May 1660 "Gorge Watson," on behalf of his son John Watson and nephew John Banges, requested that, because "Samuel Hickee" was mistakenly entered in the court records as purchaser of lands at Cushenah and Accoaksett, etc., and it should have been "Mr. Robert" Hickee, it be corrected; the matter was referred to a later court [ PCR 3:186]. On 3 October 1662 "Samuell Hickee" was offered an equal division with others in the lands of Mr. Robert Hickee at Accushena, Coaksett, etc., but he declined [ PCR 4:27]. Margaret and Samuel could not agree on the division of goods in Robert's estate and the matter was taken to court 7 June 1661 [ PCR 3:217].

On 7 October 1662 "Margarett Hickee of Plymouth, widow, as sole executrix to my husband Mr. Robert Hickee," confirmed his bequest of fifty acres to "Elnathan Chauncye the younger of the twins of Mr. Charles Chauncye" [ MD 17:240-41, citing PCLR 2:2:107].

On 22 March 1663[4] "Mistris Hickee" and "Sam[uel] Hickee" were granted Lot 7 in the Plymouth lands at "Puncateesett Necke" [ PTR 1:64].

In her will, dated 8 July 1665 and proved 6 March 1665/6, "Margarett Hickee widow of the town of Plymouth" bequeathed to "my son Samuell Hickee" £5; to "my daughter-in-law Lydia Hickee" 30s.; to "my son Samuell's children" 10s. each "there being seven of them"; said legacies to be paid by "son Samuell Hickee" from his debt "he having already received a large portion of that which God hath given me not only in lands but also in goods and chattels which was not only my husband's and son Ephraim's estate formerly but also given to me by will at my son Ephraim's death"; to "my grandchild John Banges" 40s.; residue to "the children of my son-in-law Gorg Watson and my loving daughter that is deceased Phebe Watson," also said estate to be "at the dispose of my son-in-law Gorg Watson"; "my son-in-law Gorg Watson and my friend Captain Southworth" overseers [ PCPR 2:2:32, abstracted in MD 16:157-58].

The inventory of Margaret Hickee, taken 5 March 1665[6], totalled £53 12s. 6d. and included no real estate [ PCPR 2:2:33, abstracted in MD 16:158]. On 6 March 1665/6 "Gorge Watson" was granted administration on the estate of "Mistris Margarett Hickee, deceased" [ PCR 4:117].

BIRTH: By about 1578 based on estimated date of marriage.

DEATH: Plymouth 24 May 1647 (from inventory). (Savage and Pope both give this date as 24 March, apparently based on the abstract of the inventory published in 1850 [ NEHGR 4:282]. On the original the month of death is in the upper right corner of the page, and is worn, so that only "Ma" can now be read on microfilm. Bowman saw this as May, and his reading is followed here.)

COMMENTS: The major breakthrough on this family was made when Robert S. Wakefield discovered additional baptismal entries in the St. Mary Magdalen, Bermondsey, register [ TAG 51:57-58].

Several sources give Robert Hicks two wives: Elizabeth Morgan and Margaret Winslow. No record has been found of any marriage for Robert Hicks, and his only known wife was Margaret; the argument that Margaret was a Winslow has little basis [ TAG 54:31-34].

Clement Briggs of Weymouth, fellmonger, deposed 29 August 1638 that about two and twenty years since this deponent then dwelling with one Mr. Samuell Lathame in Barmundsey Streete in Southwarke a fellmonger and one Thomas Harlow then also dwelling with Mr. Rob[er]te Heeks in the same street a fellmonger the said Harlow and this deponent had often conference together how many pelts each of their master pulled a week. And this deponent deposeth and saith that the said Rob[er]te Heeks did pull three hundred pelts a week and diverse times six or seven hundred & more a week in the killing seasons, which was the most part of the year (except the time of Lent) for the space of three or four years. And that the said Rob[er]te Heeks sold his sheep's pelts at that time for 40s. a hundred to Mr. Arnold Allard, whereas this deponent's Mr. Samuell Lathame sold his pelts for 50s. per hundred to the same man at the same time and Mr. Heeks pelts were much better ware [ PCR 12:35].

On 13 July 1639 Robert Hicks of Plymouth, "citizen & leatherseller of London," by a bill dated 6 July 1618 was indebted to Thomas Heath, citizen & cooper of London for £180, which amount was demanded by letter of attorney made by Hannah Cugley but Hicks showed an acquittance of all debts to Heath, having paid it long ago [ PCR 12:43].

---

On 6 March 1649[50] administration of the estate of Ephraim Hickee was granted to Margaret Hicks and Thomas Willet [ PCR 2:148]. The nuncupative will made by Ephraim to Mr. Thomas Southworth was set aside, Ephraim being "not in a capacity in regard of his said manner of death to make a legal will" [ PCR 3:202]. The court ordered that Ephraim's estate be set aside for the benefit of his mother, "Mistress Margaret Hickee," but the order was not recorded and Margaret had to go back to court many years later to insist it be recorded, 3 December 1660 [ PCR 3:203].

ANCESTRAL SUMMARY:

Edward Winslow was the son of Edward Winslow, a wealthy owner of a salt boilery, and Magdalene Oliver. Edward Winslow was baptized at Droitwich, Worcester, England on 20 October 1595. Winslow soon joined with the Separatists, and moved to Leyden where he became a printer along with William Brewster, publishing illegal religious pamphlets. His first wife, Elizabeth Barker, was from Chattisham, Suffolk, England.

His second wife was the widow of William White of the Mayflower. For a description of what is known about her (she is not a Fuller) see William White.

The ancestry of Edward Winslow is as follows:

(1) Kenelm Winslow of Kempsey (it has been suggested, but not proved, that he married Elizabet Foliot, daughter of John Foliot--see NEHGR 122:175-178)

(2) Edward Winslow, m. Magdalene Oliver

(3) Edward Winslow of the Mayflower

Edward Winslow had four other siblings which came to America, namely Gilbert Winslow (Mayflower, 1620), John Winslow (Fortune, 1621), Josias Winslow (White Angel, 1631), and Kenelm Winslow, who married Eleanor (Newton) Adams, who came in the Anne, 1623. Edward Winslow also had several sisters, including Magdalen who married Rev. William Wake on 25 April 1627, in Wareham, Dorset, England.

BIOGRAPHICAL SUMMARY:

Edward Winslow is the only Mayflower passenger to have a known portrait in existence--although a questionable sketch of Myles Standish exists. The portrait to the left was painted by Robert Walker in 1651, so Winslow is here 31 years older

---

than he was when he came on the Mayflower at the age of 25. The original portrait is in the possession of the Pilgrim Hall Museum in Plymouth, Massachusetts.

Nathaniel Morton in *New England's Memorial* (1669) writes of Edward Winslow:

He was the son of Edward Winslow, Esq. of the town of Draughtwich, in the county of Worcester. He, travelling into the low countries, in his journeys fell into acquaintance with the church of Leyden, in Holland, unto whom he joined, and with whom he continued until they parted to come into New-England, he coming with that part that came first over, and became a very worthy and useful instrument amongst them, both in place of government and otherwise, until his last voyage for England, being sent on special employment for the government of the Massachusetts, as is aforementioned in this book; and afterwards was employed as one of the grand commissioners in that unhappy design against Domingo in Hispaniola, who taking grief for all ill success of that enterprize, on which, together with some other infirmities that were upon him, he fell sick at sea, betwixt Domingo and Jamaica, and died the eighth day of May, which was about the sixty-first year of his life, and his body was honourably committed to the sea, with the usual solemnity of the discharge of forty-two pieces of ordinance.

Cotton Mather, essentially copying from Morton in his *Magnalia Christi Americana* (1702) writes:

Mr. Edward Winslow, the Son of Edward Winslow, Esq; of Draughtwich, in the Country of Worcester, . . . Travelling into the Low-Countries, he fell into Acquaintance with the English Church at Leyden, and joining himself to them, he Shipped himself with that part of them which first came over into America; from which time he was continually engaged in such extraordinary Actions, as the assistance of that People to encounter their more than ordinary Difficulties, called for.

Edward Winslow of the Mayflower was a printer, and assisted William Brewster in running the printing press at Leyden which published illegal pamphlets of a religious nature which were distributed in England. He was one of the more prominent and influential men in the Plymouth Colony, and was the colony's third governor. In the early years of Plymouth, Edward played a prominent role in Indian-Pilgrim relations, and made many diplomatic visits to the Wampanoag sachem Massasoit. One one occasion in 1622 he even managed to "cure" Massasoit of a dreadful sickness--an event which greatly helped Indian-Pilgrim relations.

Winslow also made trips to England in the early years of the Colony to conduct business agreements and make legal arrangements, including trips in 1623-4, 1630, and 1635. In 1646 he returned to live in England and served in the English army under Oliver Cromwell. In 1655 he died of a fever on a military expedition to capture the island of Hispaniola. Upon his death, one of the ship's chroniclers wrote this poem:

The Eighth of May, west from 'Spaniola shore,  
God took from us our Grand Commissioner,  
Winslow by Name, a man in Chiefest Trust,  
Whose Life was sweet, and Conversation just;  
Whose Parts and wisdom most men did excell:  
An honour to his Place, as all can tell.

Edward Winslow authored several books. He wrote *Good News From New England* first published in 1624. He authored a good portion of *Mourt's Relation: A Journal of the Pilgrims at Plymouth* first published in 1622. Winslow also wrote *Hypocricie Unmasked* (1646), and *New England's Salamander* (1647), which are both for the most part religious discourses. He also edited several pamphlets.

In August, 1998, Dr. Jeremy D. Bangs of Leiden, Holland stated that he was nearing completion of a biography of Edward Winslow.

Notes for Kenelm Winslow:

Emigrated to America in 1623 on Anne Ship: Unknown, 1631

Life in England: Kenelm was the son of Edward and Magdalen (Oliver/Ollyver) Winslow of Droitwich, Worcestershire. He was a joiner in New England, and would have received his training in England.

Life in New England: Kenelm Winslow first appeared in Plymouth records on the tax list of March 25, 1633, and in the list of freemen from the same year. He contracted with an apprentice, Samuel Jenny, on January 6, 1633/4. He moved to Marshfield by 1643. From 1634 to 1657 he served the colony in various offices, including



---

deputy for Marshfield to the Plymouth court for many years. Kenelm was one of five brothers (Edward, John, Gilbert, Kenelm, and Josiah) who came to New England.

Family: Kenelm Winslow married Ellen (Newton) Adams, Widow of John Adams as her second husband in June 1634 and had four children. She was buried on December 5, 1681, in Marshfield.

Children of Kenelm and Ellen Winslow:

- Kenelm was born by about 1635. He married (1) Mercy Worden by 1668 and had eleven children. He married (2) Damaris Eames by 1693.
- Ellen was born about 1636. She married Samuel Baker on December 20, 1656, and had eight children. She was buried on August 27, 1676.
- Nathaniel was born about 1639. He married Faith Miller on August 3, 1664, in Marshfield and had nine children. He died on December 1, 1719.
- Job was born by about 1641. He married Ruth \_\_\_\_\_ by 1674 and had thirteen children. He died on July 14, 1720.

- v. Gilbert Winslow was born on Nov 05, 1600 in Droitwich, Worcester, England. He died before 1650 in Great Yarmouth, England.

Notes for Gilbert Winslow:

Younger brother of Edward Winslow who also came on the Mayflower. Gilbert returned to England sometime between 1623 and 1627 and according to William Bradford writing in 1651 died in England (Mayflower Web Pages)

Birth: Gilbert Winslow was baptized on October 29, 1600, in Droitwich, Worcestershire, son of Edward and Magdalen (Oliver) Winslow.

Death: He died in England by 1650.

Ship: Mayflower, 1620

Life in England: Nothing is known of his life in England. He was there prior to July 1620 and probably returned between 1623 and 1627. There is no further information.

Life in New England: Gilbert Winslow arrived in Plymouth Colony in 1620. He received one acre in the land division of 1623, indicating he had no wife at that time. His name does not appear in the cattle division of May 1627, so he had died or left the colony by that time.

Family: His younger brother, Edward Winslow, also a passenger on the Mayflower, was governor of the Plymouth Colony.
