Greene/Green Context

Our original Green Ancestor appears to be Thomas Greene from England. We have two descendant lines with his two sons through Lieutenant Henry Green born in 1638 and Samuel Green born in 1645 both in Malden, Massachusetts.

1. Thomas Greene 1606 - 1667 [Elizabeth Lynde?]

Thomas Greene¹ was born in 1606 in St Albans, Hertfordshire, England.ⁱ There are reasons for supposing that he came from Leicestershire, but no proof of the fact. The time of his arrival in this country is also uncertain. The first record in which his name appears, to identify him, is 1653, when his youngest daughter, Dorcas, was born. Yet he doubtless came many years before, probably 1635 or 1636. We are inclined to the opinion that he lived in Ipswich till 1649 or 1650, and then removed to Malden. He certainly lived in Malden as early as Oct. 28, 1651, when his wife Elizabeth, and daughter, bearing the same name, signed a petition to the General Court.

He had a farm of 63 acres in the north part of Malden, in that part which is now the town of Melrose. A part of his farm remains to this day in the possession of his descendants.

He was selectman of Malden in 1658 and was several times on the grand jury of the County of Middlesex. As there were two other Thomas Greens in the town, he is known on the records as Thomas Green, senior; his son being junior, and the other Thomas left without any suffix.

His will dated Nov. 12, 1667; proved Jan. 15, 1667-8; recorded Midd. Prob., 5:297, mentions no wife, but makes bequests to his "eldest son" Thomas, sons John, William, Henry, Samuel, and daughters Elizabeth, Mary, Hannah, Martha, and Dorcas. Sons William and Henry were appointed executors. John Waite, John Lynde, witnesses. Inventory, Jan. 10, 1667-8; amount, '9c285.18.2.

He was married to Elizabeth [Lynde?] who died on 22 Aug 1658ⁱⁱ. Thomas Greene and Elizabeth Lynde had the following children:

Thomas Greene died 19 Dec 1667 in Malden, Massachusetts. He is buried in the Bell Rock Cemetery in Malden.ⁱⁱⁱ

Lydia Green, daughter of Lieutenant Green and Esther Hasse was born August 11, 1685, in Malden. She married Thomas Lynde 22 Jul 1708 at Malden, Middlesex, Massachusetts. She died 19 Oct 1755 in Malden.

MIGRATION: 1635 (on 2 April 1635, "Tho[mas] Greene," aged 15, was enrolled at London as a passenger for New England on the Planter [Hotten 45]; on 3 April 1635, "Tho[mas] Greene," aged 15, was enrolled at London as a passenger for New England on the Hopewell [Hotten 46]).

COMMENTS: At the end of his section on the surname Green, James Savage laments that the "stocks of Greens in our country are not exhausted; and perhaps never may be all brought into a work like this, on account

of their number.... Especially hard has been the gathering of the Malden families and those of the four, five, or six Thomases" [Savage 2:307].

In 2000 Dean Crawford Smith and Melinde Lutz Sanborn identified the English origin of the eldest Thomas Greene of Malden, showing that he was baptized on 3 February 1599/1600, and his son of the same name was born about 1630, and that the family arrived in New England some time between 1639 and 1644 [Kempton Anc 4:292-310]. Based on these dates, neither of these men can be the passenger of 1635.

A third Thomas Greene of Malden, apparently unrelated to the two discussed above, married Margaret Call, daughter of THOMAS CALL {1637, Charlestown} [MCF Folio #84]. The eldest known child of this couple was born in Malden on 1 April 1653, at which time the passenger of 1635 would have been about thirty-six years old. There is no earlier record for this Thomas Greene. We conclude that there is no evidence to connect Thomas Greene, the passenger of 1635, with any New England resident of that name.
