## Savery/Severit/Severy Context

A. W. Savery provides a lot of our information on our Savery Ancestors in "The Savery Families of America", 1887, Vol 41 NEHGR 369 to 388. Various spelling exist for the spelling of the name of related family members including, Syvret, Severit, Severy, Savery, Savory, Scivery and Sivret among French in New Brunswick Ferguson suggest the name was derived of a compound in the ancient Teutonic languages "saba" or "sabas" sword and the old German rik or rich meaning rule or dominion and generally rendered as Prince hence "Prince of the sword". The name appears in Normandy before the congress but does not show up in the Domesday Book and thus probably came to England between 1086 and the close of the following century.

Savery details other individuals bearing similar names in New England At Wenham, Essex

County Massachusetts, first settled in 1635 mention is made of a Mary, daughter of Peter and Mary Severy 1611-and the estate of Peter Severy, Sevore or Sevorce was administered by his brother Thomas in May 14 1685 and that of Andrew by his widow May 21 1745 but the earliest name that we have can trace continually back lineally as yet is John Severit who died 8 November 1742.

He married Martha Parlow who on June 11 1727 under the name of Severy was allotted one third of her husbands estate. She died 19 Dec 1768 and her death is recorded at Wedham. He died on Nov 08, 1742 in of Beverly, Essex, Massachusetts.. He married Martha Parlow or Parler. His wife died March 1737.

He bough land ar Hebron in 1753 and moved their with his family. He died at Hebron 1761.
